BY-LAW NO. 2019 –

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 2011-125, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT AND REGULATE PUBLIC NUISANCES WITHIN THE CITY OF WATERLOO

WHEREAS By-law Number 2011-125, being a by-law to prohibit and regulate public nuisances within the City of Waterloo, was passed on November 7, 2011;

AND WHEREAS it is the opinion of Council for the City that, on the dates and times as may be designated by Council from time to time, that noise, including but not limited to noise from music, which spans the width of a Highway or Public Property or is generated within a Highway or Public Property, is or could become or cause a public nuisance;

AND WHEREAS the City further deems it appropriate to amend By-law Number 2011-125 to include a requirement to provide identification;

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF WATERLOO HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 1 of By-law Number 2011-125 is hereby amended by adding the following definitions:

“Designated Time” means from 12:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on March 16, 17 and 18, in each calendar year, and such other date(s) and time(s) as Council may determine by resolution from time to time;

“Nuisance Noise” means sound or vibration that is of such volume, level or nature that is likely to disturb the inhabitants of the City, and which:

- (a) is generated on any Highway or Public Property; or
- (b) is generated on private property, and is audible at a point of reception on the opposite side of any Highway or Public Property from the property on which the sound is generated;

2. Section 2 of By-law Number 2011-125 is hereby amended by adding subsection (h), as follows:

- (h) No person shall cause or permit Nuisance Noise at any Designated Time.

3. Section 9 of By-law Number 2011-125 is hereby amended by adding subsections (b) and (c), as follows:

- (b) Every person shall, upon request by a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer or a Police Officer, for the purpose of commencing a proceeding pursuant to this by-law, provide identification, including full name and address, to the Officer.
- (c) No person shall provide false, misleading, incomplete or inaccurate identification to a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer or Police Officer.

4. By-law Number 2011-125 is further amended by adding the following Section 9(b):

- (b) The provisions of this By-law shall apply in addition to the provisions of any other applicable By-law.

5. This By-law shall come into force on the day on which it is passed.
