RE: **Waterloo West Side – Integrated Multi Modal Transportation Study**

---

To support the development of the City's West Side employment lands, staff initiated the Waterloo West Side – Integrated Multi Modal Transportation Study (IMMTS). The study area is shown on Figure 1. Following a consultant selection process in 2016, WSP was retained to conduct the study. As a comprehensive multi-year effort, this study involved various public information centres, data exchange with the Region of Waterloo, extensive numerical modelling, an independent peer review by an expert traffic engineer; and, preparation of a formal engineering report suitable for Council approval. The report will inform future development applications for lands within the study area.

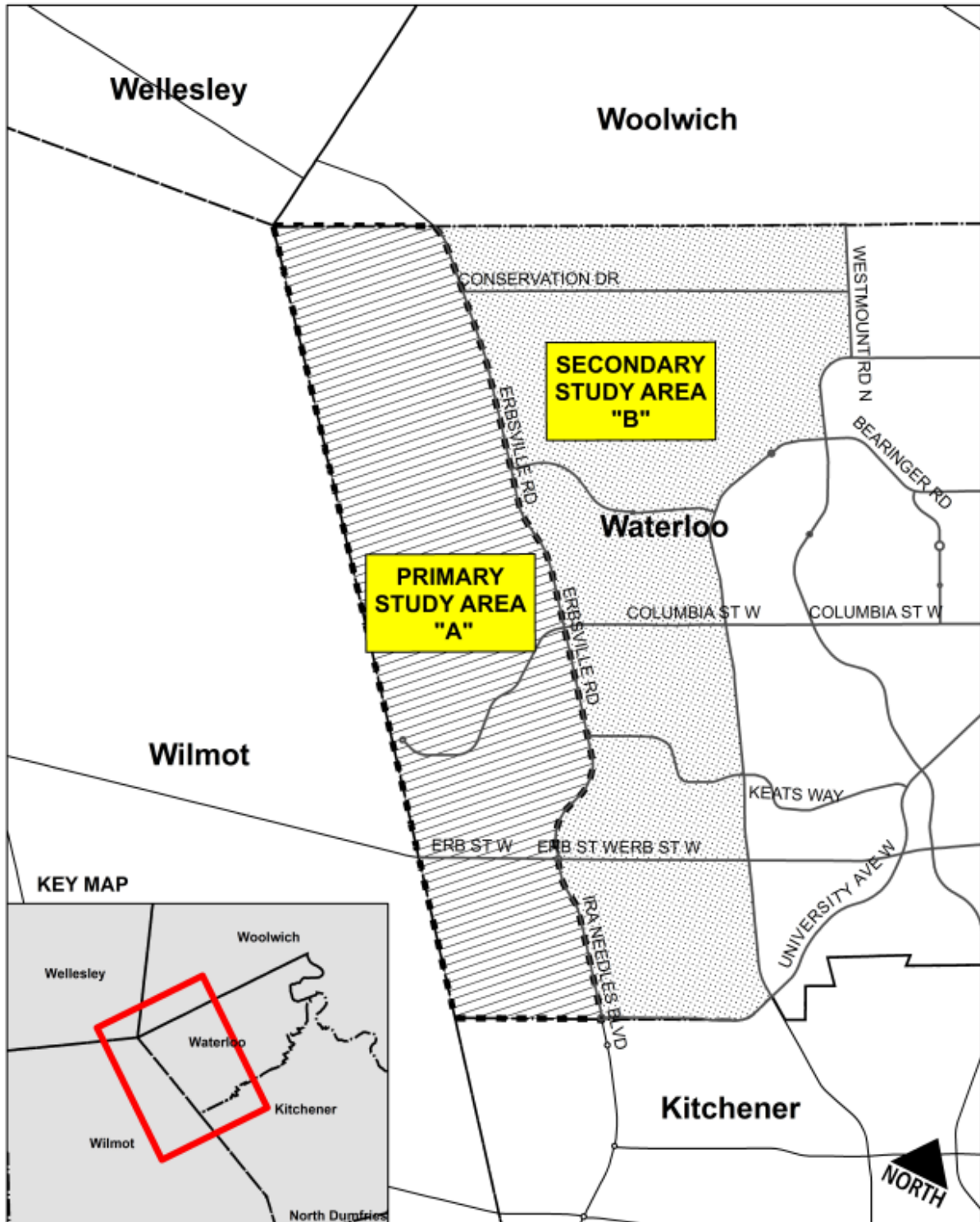
