



NOTES:

1. EXCAVATE AND CULTIVATE TO A DEPTH OF 600. IMPROVE STRUCTURE OF EXCAVATED SOIL BY AERATING, PULVERIZING, AND MIXING, REMOVING CLOUDS, LUMPS, AND DEBRIS (SUCH AS STONE, ROOTS, ETC.). BACKFILL USING IMPROVED NATIVE TOPSOIL.
2. SET CROWN OF ROOT BALL 25 ABOVE FINISHED GRADE OF PLANTING BED TO ALLOW FOR SETTLEMENT.
3. AFTER INSTALLATION OF PLANT MATERIAL, MULCH TO A DEPTH OF 100 (AFTER SETTLEMENT).
4. SOAK WITH WATER IMMEDIATELY AFTER INSTALLATION OF PLANT MATERIAL.
5. REMOVE ALL BROKEN, DISEASED, OR WEAK BRANCHES.
6. ALL SHRUB PLANT MATERIAL WILL BE PLANTED IN A COMPACT, MULCHED PLANTING BED.
