

**MAYORAL DECISION NO. 2025 – 016**

**DECISION TO GIVE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF BY-LAWS  
PREPARED FOR THE SEPTEMBER 22, 2025 MEETING OF  
COUNCIL**

**Authority:** Section 284.11 and Section 284.16 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, R.S.O 2001 provides the Mayor with the authority to veto a by-law passed by council if they believe it interferes with a prescribed provincial priority or the authority to veto a budget amendment resolution and that written approval of the by-law can be given by the Mayor.

I, Dorothy McCabe, Mayor of the City of Waterloo hereby decide to not exercise the power to veto the following by-laws passed at the Waterloo City Council meeting of September 22, 2025, in accordance with subsection 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Act.

1. All by-laws enacted with 3<sup>rd</sup> reading under the By-Laws section of the meeting and
2. The confirmatory by-law passed for such meeting of Council.

This Decision comes into effect on September 22, 2025.
