

## waterloo.ca icons

#### **ICONS**

Our icons are designed in outlines and are vector-based. They're pixel perfect and designed for optimal reading and recognition. To help overcome the ambiguity that almost all icons face ours are always accompanied by a text label.

#### **ICON DESIGN GUIDELINES**

- Keep the design simple and schematic
- Use the 5-second rule: if it takes you more than 5 seconds to think of an appropriate icon for something, it is unlikely that an icon can effectively communicate that meaning
- Test the icons for recognizability: ask people what they expect the icons to stand for
- Test the icons for memorability: ask a repeat set of users if they can remember the icon's meaning after being told what it represented a couple weeks earlier
- Always include a visible text label

### Parks + facilities

Park locations, services and rentals, community centres, cemeteries and city hall



### News + events

Event calendar, news releases, public notices, service alerts, social media

- Only use photography we have permission to use. If unsure on permissions do not use.
