

- A. 2.5m MINIMUM FOR CHANNELIZED ISLAND
- B. MINIMUM 1.5m CLEAR WIDTH REQUIRED IN ALL DIRECTIONS BETWEEN CURBS WITH A MAX. SLOPE
- C. LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION WILL VARY BASED ON THE RUNNING SLOPE OF SIDEWALK, CROSS SLOPE OF SIDEWALK, AND HEIGHT OF CURB.
- 1. DEPRESSED CURBS TO BE PROVIDED FOR WIDTH OF ALL PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS.
- 2. TACTILE WALKING SURFACE INDICATORS TO BE PROVIDED ONLY WITHIN WIDTH OF PEDESTRIAN
- 3. TACTILE WALKING SURFACE INDICATORS ARE TO BE INSTALLED AT ALL PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS IN CONJUNCTION WITH ALL ROAD AND SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION AND RESURFACING PROJECTS (WHERE APPLICABLE)
- EACH LOCATION IS SITE SPECIFIC AND CONSULTATION WITH THE CITY OF WATERLOO MAY
- 5. CHANNELIZED ISLAND GEOMETRY IS CONCEPTUAL ALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS AND SIGNAGE PER CONTRACT DRAWINGS, OR, AS DIRECTED BY CITY OF
- PLATES ARE TO BE UNCOATED CAST IRON MATERIAL WITH NATURAL "RUST" FINISH (REFER TO REGION OF WATERLOO STANDARD SPECIAL PROVISIONS RWSS 14 FOR LISTED/APPROVED SUPPLIERS)
- FOR DEPRESSED CURBS AT SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS, REFER TO REGION OF WATERLOO
- REFER TO CW-221 FOR COLOURED IMPRESSED CONCRETE COLOUR AND DETAILS.
